

The Bridge Missional Communities Summer Arts Camp Counsellor

Job Description Purpose:

The purpose of the Summer Arts Camps is to give local children the opportunity to explore and learn different medias of communication through various art forms,during week long summer events. As they learn about issues of social justice prevalent in our world today.

Purpose of the Camp Counsellor:

To support the direction of the camp and see that the summer camp experience has the best possible outcomes.

Position Availability:

Position runs six weeks beginning July 6th through August 21 with one week off July 24th- August 2nd. Compensation: \$14/hour for 30 hours per week including prep and meetings. Camps run Monday to Thursday, 12-4pm and a gallery night on Thursday 6:30-7:30 pm. Staff are there at 10 am and leave after cleanup.

Mentorship:

The student will be mentored by the Bridge Leadership Team and the camp director, who will offer insight into capabilities and areas for improvement in working with the campers and tasks assigned. Mentorship will include space for the student to exercise autonomy, and agency in managing this project to ensure experience is relevant to the student's academic and career goals.

Duties:

1. To work with the camp director in support of the overall camp program.
2. Help assist students and teach art and group activities.
3. Keep children organized and on task.
4. Help organize, prepare and cleanup for every day of camp.

Qualifications:

1. Youth between the ages of 17 to 30 years.
2. The ability to work in a team setting.
3. A follower of Jesus who desires to live and work within a missional environment and shows a deep willingness to learn what God may have in store for them.
4. A love for children and ability to work closely with them.
5. A deep concern for issues of justice as understood from a biblical worldview.
6. A completed vulnerable sector background check, due by July 1st.
7. First Aid and CPR are assets.
